Camperships are given to make up the difference that a Scout, his family, and the unit cannot cover towards his camp fees. **Generally, the Council campership grant is not more than 40 – 50 percent of the total camp fee.** The campership committee feels that it is important for a Scout to contribute some portion of his fees through personal resources, or unit fund raising projects, thus meeting the spirit of the 9th point of the Scout Law – “A Scout is Thrifty” – a Scout pays his own way. Campership funds are restricted to Los Padres Council Camp participants only.
